The criteria for the Timothy Briggs Scholarship are as follows:

- High school **SENIOR** student in the North Alabama Area
- Cumulative grade point average of 3.00 or above
- Evidence of community service and leadership ability
- Personal Statement addressing the topic
The following are the judging criteria for your statement:
 - ORIGINALITY - uniqueness of thought (50%)
 - CONTENT - supporting text and/or graphics (25%)
 - PRESENTATION - clarity of expression, quality of grammar, and neatness of presentation (25%)
- Will attend an accredited 4 yr. college or university the following school year
- Three signed letters of recommendation (1 teacher, 1 community service affiliation & 1 personal)
- Required to undergo a panel interview (finalists only)

Timothy Briggs Scholarships winner will receive \$2500. The scholarship will be paid to the college upon receiving acceptable proof of attendance from a university or college.
