The North Alabama Chapter of the National Society of Black Engineers Professionals (NAL NSBE Professionals) invites middle-school students to participate in our Space Camp/Academy Scholarship. NAL NSBE Professionals was established out of a need to stimulate and sustain minority participation in Engineering and the Applied Sciences. This chapter of NSBE Professionals encourages and advises youth in their pursuit of careers in engineering and the applied sciences by offering programs and services that include Scholarship Endowment, Tutorial Programs, Advanced Study Skills and much more. In keeping with its objectives, the NAL NSBE Professionals is providing the opportunity for minority students to attend the US Space Camp/Academy.

The NAL NSBE Professionals will award four Space Camp Scholarships to minority youths within North Alabama. The scholarship covers a weeklong program at the US Space Camp/Academy, including meals, educational materials, housing accommodations, and paraphernalia. The US Space Camp/Academy is an educational program that couples classroom instruction with hands on activities. Trainees learn about space flight and the space program from attending lectures and seminars, and put this information to practical use with simulators and tours.

You can help the NAL NSBE Professionals select qualified minority students for the scholarship by recommending deserving students. Candidates should satisfy the following criteria:

- Students currently in grades 6th, 7th, or 8th
- Interested in engineering and applied sciences or STEM fields
- Strong academic background
- Financial Need
- Interview for finalists will be required
- Not previously attended US Space Camp/Academy

Each applicant is required to complete the following steps before his/her application will be processed:

- 1. Complete the scholarship application form.
- 2. Submit at least one Teacher Recommendation form.
- 3. Submit at least one Personal Reference Recommendation form.
- 4. Submit an essay on the question from the scholarship application form (attached). The essay will be judged on the following criteria:
 - ORIGINALITY uniqueness of thought, but not necessarily scientific or technical expertise.
 - LEVEL OF INTEREST enthusiasm for the US Space Camp/Academy programs and general interest in the space program.
 - PRESENTATION clarity of expression, quality of grammar (appropriate to grade), and neatness of presentation.
- **5.** Mail your Application, Teacher Recommendation, Personal Recommendation forms and essay to the address listed below

All forms must be submitted in the same envelope, and all entries must be **postmarked on or before Tuesday**, **January 16**, **2018**. The scholarships will cover registration and enrollment for one week during the summer session and will be awarded at the NAL NSBE Professionals 25th Annual Scholarship Awards Banquet scheduled for **Thursday**, **March 8**, **2018**. If you are selected as a finalist, a **formal interview will be scheduled and conducted at a later date**.

There is no limit on the number of students that can participate from each school, church, or community. You may apply for duplicate NSBE Scholarships, but you are only eligible to win **ONE** per year.
